

CACM Names New Director of Education & Credentialing

Judy Levinsohn, an educational leader with diverse experience both inside and outside the classroom, has joined the California Association of Community Managers as its new director of education & credentialing.

For the last 10 years, Levinsohn has worked at the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE), where she most recently served as the administrator of the Institute for Leadership Development, overseeing five credential programs and leadership academies offered to educators across the county. She also represented the OCDE as a member of state-sponsored committees who provided insight to legislative as well as credentialing policymakers in Sacramento.



After moving to Orange County 24 years ago, Levinsohn taught in the Capistrano Unified School District before serving as a school administrator in the Tustin Unified School District. She then moved to WestEd, a non-profit research and development organization where, as a senior research associate, she specialized in strategic planning and providing professional development in support of those processes.

Originally from the East Coast, Levinsohn attended Ithaca College where she received her bachelor's degree in social studies. She then attended the University of Virginia, where she completed her master's degree in education.
